2005 and 2006 escapes data obtained from Scottish Executive in Feb 2007 in response to FOI request by Pure Salmon Campaign.

Partial 2007 data (through Sept) obtained from Scottish Executive in Oct 2007 in response to FOI request by Pure Salmon Campaign.

**Escapes Data Notes:**

In 2005, 3 incidents reported zero escapes

In 2006, 4 of the incidents reported zero escapes.

In 2006, 130,000 reported "dead": In 2005, 125,000 "dead". Some "dead" listed as "recovered"; some as n/a

On Sept 14, 2007 Fjord Seafood reported an escapes with an initial estimate of 29,500.

Scottish Executive notes it is

"Awaiting final notification" of no. fish escaped and recovered
